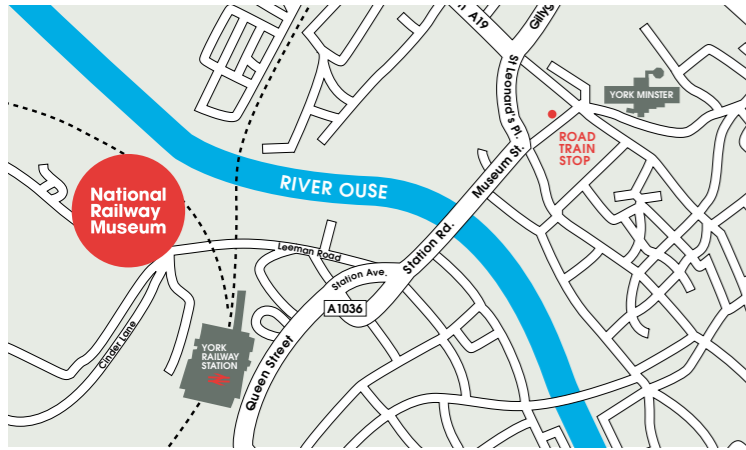

## Organising your group visit

### Onsite coach parking & coach drop-off points

Entry to the Museum is free, however, we do provide all day coach parking at a small charge of £10 for pre-booked groups. Coaches are permitted to pull in and drop-off in the large space located outside the car park entrance. For any visitors with a disability, coaches are permitted to drop-off at the city entrance. Both entrances are for dropping off only. When you make a booking we will also send you a map highlighting the Museums coach parking facilities and drop-off points.

### Average visit time

2 - 3 hours.

### Guided tours

Groups are welcome to join any of our free guided tours which take place each day in the Museum. For details and times of specific talks, please ask our staff on arrival.

### Group catering

Exploring is hungry work - so why not enjoy morning coffee, afternoon tea or lunch at our onsite café or restaurant or relax with a picnic in South Yard. We can even make arrangements for private dining in our luxurious Pullman carriage, Valiant. Available only to pre-booked groups. Please enquire at the time of booking.

### Road train

After your visit to the Museum, why not take a trip into York on the Road Train which runs between the Museum and York Minster. Charges apply; please check the website for full details and running times. 2 for 1 tickets from York Minster to the Museum are available when you pre-book a group visit.

### Location

The Museum is just a short walk from York city centre and 540 metres (600 yards) from York Railway Station. Follow the signs from the station.
